## Suspect Search Update

The City of Lafayette Police Department is providing information about a crime that recently occurred within the City. The purpose of this bulletin is to inform residents about the incident and to obtain additional information to aid the police department in our investigation.

This is an update to the previous bulletin sent out regarding the two large-scale police searches that were recently done within our community. This morning we have released the identity of the suspect who is linked to both of these recent incidents.

While officers were able to identify the suspect following the initial incident, investigators requested time to show photo displays to witnesses from the various crimes committed by the suspect. Those displays have now been completed and the name and photo of the suspect were released to the media this morning. By releasing the name and photo of the suspect, it's our hope it will lead to the arrest of the suspect.

We have found nothing to indicate the suspect is currently in our community.

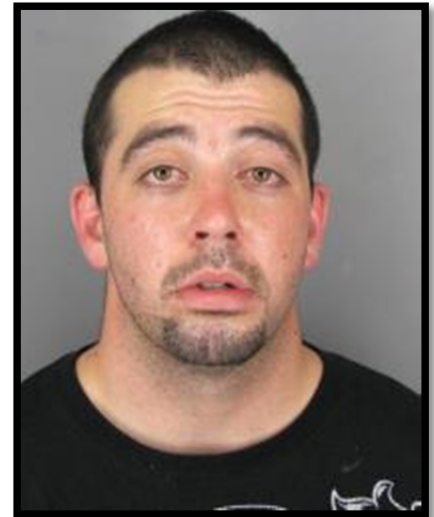
Here's what was released to the media this morning:

The Lafayette Police Department is currently looking for 28-year-old Alexander William Anderson in connection with a series of property crimes and an assault with a deadly weapon on a peace officer in Lafayette. A \$175,000 warrant has been issued for his arrest.

Anderson has previously given police the false name of "Efron Curiel."

Anderson is described as a white male, 5'10", 160 pounds, with black colored hair and hazel colored eyes. His previous residences include Antioch, Bay Point, Bethel Island, Concord and Pittsburg.

The Lafayette Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in locating Anderson. He should not be approached or contacted.
